

ANGLO EUROPEAN SCHOOL Sixth Form Students' Destinations – 2023



Students make informed decisions regarding their next destination with the guidance of a destinations mentor. On average, over 80% of students go on to university to study a range of courses. In 2023, 84% of students went to university, of which 30% went to Russell Group institutions and 3% went to study overseas. 5% of students proceeded straight to employment, 2% took an apprenticeship and 9% gap year or went travelling. Recent international destinations include Universiteit van Amsterdam, Nagoya University in Japan, Princeton University in the USA and IE University in Spain.
