<p><b>SYNOPSIS OF CONTENT:</b></p> <p>Areas of interest: Identities; Experiences; Human ingenuity; Social organisation; A planet for everyone.</p> <p>Students will study two pieces of literature in the form of two plays (<i>Der Besuch der alten Dame</i> and <i>Andorra</i>). Students are expected to reach a high degree of competence in a language and explore the culture using the language.
