Planning Permission granted at Anglo European School

This is a significant development in the project and has granted permission for the redevelopment of the existing school buildings, construction of a new three storey school building, canopy structure, new car park, amphitheatre, MUGA and soft and hard landscaping. The new building is significant in stature, innovative and sustainable in its design and reflects the school's unique international ethos and specialisms. It will endeavour to meet net carbon zero in operation and provide brand new, significantly improved facilities for Anglo European School students.
