SYNOPSIS OF CONTENT:

Aspects of society, culture and history of the Russian-speaking world including: Political and current affairs and history, intellectual and artistic culture, past and present. Students will use authentic spoken and written sources from a variety of contexts and genres. Students will develop research skills in the language including on subjects of personal interest related to the Russian Speaking world. There is a prescribed list of grammar for A level that students will be expected to study and apply in class and in their independent study. Literature - study of two prescribed works: Queen of Spades by Pushkin, and the film Burnt by the Sun by Nikita Mikalhov.
