

## **Dress code**

The Dress Code set out below recognises that you are young adults in a school community with a cosmopolitan, yet professional ethos. You are role models to our younger students and set the standards to them.

Failure to follow the below will lead to a sanction.

### **Tops:**

- No sports shirts
- All tops must be long enough to be able to be tucked into trousers, shorts or skirts
- No vest, low cut, sleeveless, off the shoulder, spaghetti or strapless tops or dresses
- No logos or slogans except that of the manufacturer
- No ripped / torn tops

### **Bottoms:**

- No tracksuit bottoms
- No leggings
- No sports or gym shorts
- No ripped or torn bottoms
- There must be no more than the width of a mobile phone between the knee and the hem of a shirt or shorts or dress

### **Shoes:**

- No flip flops, sliders or heels.

### **Accessories:**

- The Sixth Form lanyard, displaying your picture card, must be always worn
- Underwear must be always covered
- No hats, durags, caps, bandanas, bonnets or hoods worn on school site
- No sunglasses
- No facial piercings except ear studs
- No mobile phones, head/earphones are to be visible whilst walking around the school site. They will be confiscated by a member of staff.
