Policy Statement

As a school, we believe that uniform promotes a sense of pride, shared identity and belonging.

All students are to wear the correct uniform throughout the day. It is an expectation of students to wear their uniform during the school day and visits, unless indicated otherwise by the Headteacher. School uniform is enforced and sanctions, such as detentions, can be issued for breaches of policy.

Uniform is not a fashion item. It is designed to be both formal and comfortable and whilst wearing it, students are ambassadors for the school and the standards of behaviour set out in our behaviour policy.

In the case of extreme weather, the Headteacher has discretion to relax the uniform policy. This will be communicated to students as they arrive at the school. Students should assume that, unless directed otherwise, they should wear their usual uniform each day. An optional navy polo shirt with printed school logo is available to purchase through one of our uniform suppliers for the summer term only.

Our uniform policy is agreed with the Behaviour and Attitudes Student Committee and in consultation with staff and parents.

Parents are free to purchase school uniform from any supplier if it conforms to the uniform requirements and the colours established by the school's suppliers.

All items of clothing should be clearly marked with the student's name. Lost property is housed within the school. Students can enquire about lost items by contacting Student Services. Unclaimed lost property is disposed of at the end of every half term or distributed to other students as part of the second hand uniform or charitable provision. The school and their insurers cannot take responsibility for personal property.

If your child is eligible for the pupil premium grant and needs support with providing uniform, please make the Achievement Co-ordinator (PPG) aware, via Student Services, and they will liaise with you or your child to ensure that uniform is made available for your child. They will make contact with all Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) eligible families on entry to the school at the point of transition to ensure every child has uniform to start the school year.

For the purposes of this policy uniform refers to school uniform and PE kit.

Uniform Donations:

Uniform to donate should be nearly new, clean and reusable. Donations should be made by contacting the school office to arrange a time to drop off or send the uniform into school with your child and ask them to leave it at Student Services.

If there are any concerns about uniform, please contact the school office or if new to the school, contact the Admissions Manager, who will be able to assist all new students' access suitable uniform supplies.

Uniform List - Years 7 - 11

All students in Years 7-11 are required to wear the correct school uniform. Parents are free to purchase any item of uniform from any supplier if it conforms to the uniform requirements and the colours established by the school's suppliers.

Main School Uniform: *These items can be purchased from Price and Buckland and PMG**Main School Uniform 1:**

- Navy blazer with school badge*
- Plain white shirt with collar, to be worn tucked in and with a school tie*
- Black trousers (ankle length, tailored and not flared). Denim, cords, lycra and leggings are not acceptable
- Plain black/navy socks

Or

Main School Uniform 2:

- Navy blazer with school badge*
- Gold blouse with collar, to be worn tucked in with no tie
- Navy knife pleat skirt with school badge*
- Plain black/navy socks, black/navy tights (not both)

Optional:

- A plain navy V-necked pullover with gold trim, with **or** without school badge* may be worn, but only under a blazer
- Pin badge (Year 7 students)

Shoes:

- Plain black shoes without commercial logos
- No boots, sandals, trainers, plimsolls or canvas shoes

- Shoes should be of a safe and sensible style. Shoes should have a low heel. High heels of any sort are not acceptable
- Black shoe laces

Jewellery:

- For reasons of safety, only limited items of jewellery are permitted. In the case of pierced ears, one pair of plain metal studs in the ear lobes may be worn but are not encouraged. These must be removed for P.E. so any new piercing must be done at the start of the six-week holidays. Parents who wish their child to wear a piece of jewellery for religious reasons must apply to the Headteacher in writing for their agreement
- No other facial or visible body piercings are allowed; this includes nose and tongue piercings
- No smart watches

Make Up & Accessories:

- Makeup should be subtle and minimal
- Hand decoration is not permitted, unless for religious observance
- Nail varnish or false nails are not permitted
- False eyelashes are not permitted
- No sunglasses

Headwear:

- All accessories must be black or navy
- There is no restriction on hair colour or style
- Long or beaded hair must be pulled back for sports and practical subjects
- No headscarves except for religious reasons

Outdoor Wear Only:

- Plain black or navy coat with minimal logo. No leather or denim
- Plain, dark hats, scarves and gloves
- Hooded tops are not permitted
- Clothing associated with sports teams (other than AES) are not permitted

PE KIT - Appendix 2 *These items can be purchased from Price and Buckland

Essential:

- Royal blue polo shirt with yellow piping and school badge*
- Royal blue skort **or** Royal blue shorts with yellow piping and school badge*
- Royal blue socks* with yellow top
- Rugby gum shield
- Royal blue reversible Rugby shirt with yellow piping, with **or** without yellow piping and school badge* **and/or** Royal blue sweatshirt with yellow piping, with or without yellow piping and school badge*

Optional:

- Navy blue tracksuit with or without yellow piping and school badge*
- Royal blue or black base layer top
- Royal blue or black base layer leggings

PE Footwear:

Sports training shoes (not plimsolls), no Velcro fastenings.

Any colour football or rugby boots and football shin pads.

Wearing Glasses Whilst Playing Sports:

If your child needs to wear glasses in order to safely participate in PE and be able to see clearly, they are required to wear specialist sports glasses for any contact sports such as football and rugby. You may also wish to consider sports glasses for other ball games such as netball and basketball.

Sixth Form Dress Code

Our dress code recognises that you are young adults in a school with an international and diverse community with an academic ethos. The code provides you with greater freedom for self-expression but also reflects that you are role models for students in the main school and that you share the workplace with professionals. Complete lanyards must be worn at all times; this is the safeguarding policy of the school and protects us all. Any breach of this code will be challenged and sanctioned.

Tops:

A choice of T-shirt, polo top, shirt or blouse of any colour. Accompanying jumpers and jackets may be worn.

Students should not wear:

- Tops, jumpers or jackets which display offensive language; are sleeveless, transparent, low cut, “crop top” design, ripped or torn
- Tops which are not long enough to tuck into trousers or skirts
- Sports team or gym wear tops

Dresses:

Dresses must be an appropriate length, no shorter than just above the knee. They must not be sleeveless, low cut, display offensive language, be ripped or torn.

Bottoms:

A choice of tailored trousers, jeans, cargos, skirt or tailored shorts (tailored shorts in the summer term only). Underwear must be covered at all times.

Students should not wear:

- Ripped or torn trousers
- Tracksuit/loungewear bottoms, skorts, playsuits, gym wear or leggings
- Skirts which are no shorter than just above the knee

Shoes and accessories:

To adhere to health and safety requirements of a busy school site, certain shoes and accessories are not permitted.

Students should not wear:

- Shoes which are flip flops, sliders, ugg style or croc style
- Any head covering except for religious purposes as agreed by the Director of Sixth Form
- Sunglasses in the school building
- Facial piercings except for ear studs
- Mobile phones, head/earphones and airpods should not be visible whilst walking around the school site

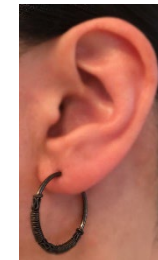
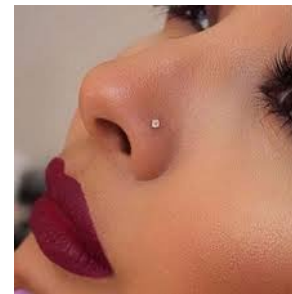
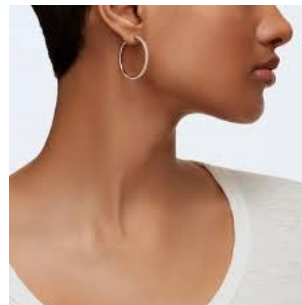
