PROJECT 2 – 3D

(Observational drawings, Cardboard (cut, score, manipulate), Artist research, Paper folding)

- are becoming more confident with independent decision making
- can create a faceted 3D form (FP)
- can use craft knives effectively and safely to cut and score cardboard precisely
- can use a hot glue gun safely to make a sturdy structure
- can use different materials to create texture when working in 3D
