 To encourage students to become active global citizens who are internationally minded, resilient risk-takers who become reflective and insightful learners.

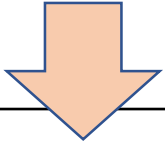

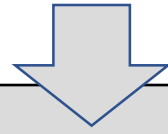
