The Anglo European School Library is open throughout the school day and is a vibrant, busy and popular area of the school where students are able to study, work and read in an engaging environment.

All students are encouraged to use the wide range of exceptional and diverse resources available to them within the library for assistance and progress with their studies, as well as for leisure and general interest, and to enable them to develop their independent study skills. Sixth Formers are also welcome to use the library for private study during their study periods. We also encourage our Sixth Formers to join their local public library and we can offer advice on how to do this.

Furthermore, there is a dedicated Sixth Form Study Resources room, The William Tweed Reference Library, which is situated within the Sixth Form Study Room. Please Note: Items in this collection are for reference only and as such may only be used within the Study Room.

As a member of the Anglo European School Sixth Form your daughter/son is automatically enrolled into the main school Library and can borrow up to 3 items at a time. Most books have a lending period of 3 weeks, with periodicals and magazines available for one week.

To ensure that the resources in the Library are available to all students, we do ask that resources are returned on time and in a suitable condition. Therefore, we expect that any item(s) that are lost or damaged are replaced. When this occurs, students will be informed. If the items are not then replaced or returned, a letter will be sent home and we will request either the item is replaced or for a contribution of £5. If a lost item is paid for and then subsequently returned, a refund will be given providing the resource is in a suitable condition.
